JOB PURPOSE

 This post involves working with small groups of pupils to get them accredited outcomes linked to the construction industry

- Line manage a teaching assistant
- To ensure the Health and Safety of the workshop environment
- To encourage pupils in personal development, achievement and integration into the school
- To represent the school and work as part of a multi-agency team along with parents and carers
- To support pupils at college and other provisions
- To support out of classroom activities as part of a broad and varied curriculum
- To ensure Child Protection and Safeguarding is of paramount importance
- Follow procedures for accident, illness, absconding and absence for pupils and to adhere to all school policies
- Prepare, plan and deliver a curriculum suitable for the individual needs of pupils
- Update contact information, pen portraits, risk assessments and timetables for each pupil when required
- To report on pupils' progress when required
- Contribute to any meetings that are called for the education and welfare of pupils
- Attend department, behaviour whole school staff meetings
